Keeping in accordance with the aims and objectives and to stimulate research activities in the campus we have initiated a Multifarious Science Forum in the collaboration with all the science departments in the college. The forum is successfully working with the sole objective to make the students and faculty members familiar with the innovations in the subject. The forum untiringly works and propagates advanced teaching techniques and catalyzes inter-disciplinary research activities in the campus.

The forum provides a unique platform to the students to freely discuss all their educational needs and support. In addition to that the forum organizes intellectual talks and educational presentations like poster presentations and group discussions to develop research attitude among the students.

As per the directions received from the department of higher education we have initiated a research journal SHODHODAYA in the institute comprising the subject experts from the distinguished colleges of the district. The editorial panel invites the research papers from the faculty members' district wide and there is a clear author guidelines proposed by the panel. To financially assist the publication of research journal we have a voluntarily proposed a scheme of providing about five thousands rupees from the various colleges of the district to subsidize any financial burden. But due to the pandemic covid and some other unavoidable reasons, the publication of Shodhodaya could not be regularized. Although the re-publication of Shodhodaya is under consideration and its publication will be started soon.

To promote research activities in future we have UGC and RUSA cell. The college is well determined to enhance and trigger the research culture in the institute.

To initiate the research aptitude among students we facilitate them with journals of high reputation and study materials.

We invite requisitions from the departments to assist the practical works to meet the research demands.

The approved proposals are thereby purchased and distributed under RUSA scheme.

The faculty members are motivated and encouraged to undertake Minor Research Projects.

We had subscribed the facilities of INFLIBLIT, N-LIST and provide the e-book and e-journal facilities in the campus.

Teachers are encouraged to participate in Seminars/Conferences /Workshops at National and Inter-National level and the expenditures on such career enhancement skills are reimbursed as per the UGC rules. The teachers are further obliged with DUTY LEAVE to participate in such academic gatherings.

Study leave is provided to the faculty members who have completed five years of regular services to complete their research work of PH.D. Any academician can organize the National and International Seminars /Workshops in the College to upgrade the knowledge and research work.
